Job Summary:

The Hospice RN is a registered professional nurse who ensures quality of patient care in the home. The primary function is for the overall supervision of patient care and monitoring of appropriate staffing and productivity. Coordinates care with the Interdisciplinary Group/Team, patient, family, and referring agency.

Performs duties in an office environment during hospice operating hours. If required to make patient visits, may work in patient's home in various conditions; possible exposure to blood, bodily fluids, and infectious diseases; ability to work a flexible schedule; ability to travel locally; some exposure to unpleasant weather; PRN emergency call. Must be available at all times during operating hours.

Duties:

- Directs and coordinates patient care. Assumes responsibility for continuity, quality, and safety of services delivered in compliance with State and federal regulations. (Conditions of Participation).
- Participates in activities relevant to professional services, including development of agency personnel.
- Supervises and provides direction to subordinates, in an effort to ensure quality, compliance with Plan of Care, and assessment and reassessment of patients' needs and continuity of services by appropriate health care personnel.
- Monitors QA/PI Program and assures appropriate corrective measures are performed.
- Promotes compliance with all fiscal intermediary and/or other third-party payors.
- Monitors systems and identifies problem areas to DON, both verbally and through written reports.
- Meets mandatory continuing education requirements of the agency/licensing board.

- Promotes and educates regarding the concepts of infection control and standard precautions in coordinating/performing patient care activities to prevent contamination and transmission of disease

Requirements:

- Education: Graduate of an accredited Diploma, Associate, or Baccalaureate School of Nursing.
- Licensure: Current state license as a Registered Nurse. Current driver's license
- Experience: Minimum of three years of experience as a registered nurse and experience in hospice preferred. Management experience is also preferred.
- Skills: Nursing skills as defined as generally accepted standards of practice. Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to communicate effectively. Demonstrates proven decision-making skills. Must read, write, and comprehend English.
